Your Submission:	The Canterbury Rowing Assn are concerned at the proposal to drop the funding set aside for a new flatwater sports venue in the draft city plan.[p 83]. Kerrs Reach is woefully inadequate for the current pressures from a variety of users. It falls far short of acceptable competition & safety standards. In the last season thae Canterbury Rowing Assn recorded a 50 % growth, this came principally from youth. The ecosure report of 24 May 2004 states the bird strike risk is already present, no alternative site has been identified & in addressing the present bird strike risk there is a clear pathway for the CCC, the airport & Lake Isaac proponents to advance together to minimise vermin bird population over a much larger area than the airport confines. As well as protecting the airport from development encroachment CCC control by head lease could enable considerable flood protection whilst providing a recreational asset that would benefit Christchurch's economy and quality of life. This is a unique opportunity to recognise a munificent offer to equal the foresight of 150 years ago that gave us Hagley Park. Cooperation & compromise between all parties can ensure that Lake Isaac becomes a reality for a host of sport and recreational users.
