Submission to the Christchurch City Council Draft Annual Plan 2006

This submission is made in my personal capacity as an individual member of the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board.

I'd like to recommend:

- 1. That the Council set a budget of \$10,000 to promote New Zealand Local Music Month within Christchurch.
- 2. That the Council set an objective of promoting, and developing local Christchurch contemporary music.
- 3. That budget provision is made to support the above point through the funding of a local music coordinator/advisor.
- 4. That the Council resolve to re-establish the Christchurch City Youth Council as a priority.
- 5. That the Council be commended for its production of the local civic education resource.
- 6. That the Council set aside a budget provision to resource all elected members with an equal communications allowance. This works out to an additional \$11,520 for broadband provision and \$34,560 for cellular/phone communications per year so that community board members can receive the same level as chairs of the community boards and the city councillors.
- 7. That the Council use the Capital Endowment Fund to help contribute to social housing development projects rather than through raising the existing rents of City Housing tenants.
- 8. That the Council divide the Capital Endowment Fund into four sections (social, civic, economic, and environmental) and that the money allocated to each section be the ¼ of the total money available for distribution each year.
- 9. That the Council be commended for the social funding it distributes every year and that the existing levels be continued or increased.
