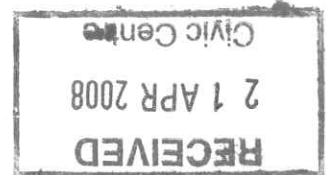

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It will help us if in your submission you clearly state your opinion on the proposed route and describe/outline any ideas/issues you may have.

Our Group is fully supportive of the Tram extension through CASHEL MAU and beyond HIGH STREET.

We suggest, rather than have the Loop around CASHEL, Manchester STREETS, the Tram Line extends along HIGH STREET to the PolyTECH Loop. The main reason for this is our 3000m² Market Development opposite the PolyTECH at 293-295 ST. ASAPH Street through to 264-268 Tuam Street (currently operating as "My Favorite THINGS." These addresses are connected for Free Flow of Pedestrian Foot Traffic from ST. ASAPH to Tuam Street and eventually the entrance of Turners & Growers Development, when it's complete.

Our Market concept is unique. It is similar to "The PIKE Market" Seattle, USA. and Moore & Wilson's - Auckland & Wellington Markets.

We see this area as a major new attraction for the people of CHRISTCHURCH and Tourists.

We would like to see a BIKE/Walking Track extending to AMI STADIUM for the Rugby World Cup.

We recommend a TOTAL Concept including PolyTECH, Music Centre, Basilica and AMI STADIUM.
