# Proposal for the Extension to the Tram Route

## Submission Form

It will help us if in your submission you clearly state your opinion on the proposed route and describe/outline any ideas/issues you may have.

I agree with the general concept of the Proposed extended tram route.

Three sections are of interest as a layman - some of these have been discussed with Dave Hinman briefly.

1/ Manchester Street - Crossing the flow of traffic twice - this is a very busy street with traffic backed up especially travelling North. Changing the direction would keep the tram in the flow - though the left turns could be difficult especially Manchester into Cashel.

2/ Oxford Terrace - suggest tram rails moved closer to "the Strip" similar to New Regent Street. The road moved a little closer to the river if necessary - by reducing a very low use footpath - and keeping the traffic flow as is - South to North - unless the 'No Left Turn' at from Lichfield Street into Colombo Street is removed.

3/ Colombo Street - Cathedral Square - The orange route looks the best as it does not impede traffic greatly travelling behind the Cathedral.
