

Prepare and implement a conservation plan for Friendship Corner, as part of the heritage setting for the Bridge of Remembrance. Link the walkway/cycleway "promenade" along Oxford Terrace to the City Mall. This park is commemorative theme area and is suitable setting for an artwork. Advice on the suitability of future tree plantings should be sought from arborists within Council's Greenspace Unit. As trees age they should be replaced with the same species.

Protect the gravelly, fast-flowing channel between the Cambridge Terrace riverbank and the island as an important habitat for trout. Investigate ways of improving the area as a source of food for the trout.

Prepare and implement a conservation plan that will protect and enhance the cultural heritage values of the planting on the island and the natural heritage values of the surrounding river, including the treatment of the riverbanks and the enhancement of trout habitat. Include planting of podocarps to complement kowhai, cabbage tree and hoherias with second tier of camellias and rhododendrons and an under-storey of native ferns and small shrubs.

Add Prunus, Ginkgo or Sequoia feature trees, plus totara and Garden City style shrubs, bulbs and ground covers, and riverbank sedges. Realign footpath and add seating and access to riverbank

Plant the steep slope with ferns and flowering bulbs. Extend the toeslope into the river to narrow the riverbed

Narrow the waterway by extending the toeslope of the south bank into the river and creating an informal riverside pathway running under the Montreal Street bridge

Remove carparks from bridge, widen and pave footpath, improve pedestrian crossings. Upgrade bridge lighting and enhance balustrade with artistic elements. Plant native shrubs to soften bridge abutments.

Replace ivy with indigenous riparian sedges and ferns to cover retaining wall and steep banks

Widen this footpath to 2.8m wide

Explore opportunities for turning this outfall into a landscape feature

The existing footpath is to become a walkway/cycleway "promenade"
Investigate the interpretation of the history of this area's use for swimming

Remove existing kerbside car parking and replace with a widened footpath along Oxford Terrace to become a walkway/cycleway "promenade". Redefine cycle and vehicle lane markings. Plant avenue of specimen lime trees (*Tilia petiolaris*).

Establish guidelines for conservation management of this berm as the heritage setting for the adjacent heritage building, including continuation of the existing lease of part of the berm. Plant three kowhai on river edge
