

Silver birch removed to create an opening and other trees elevated to create viewing window

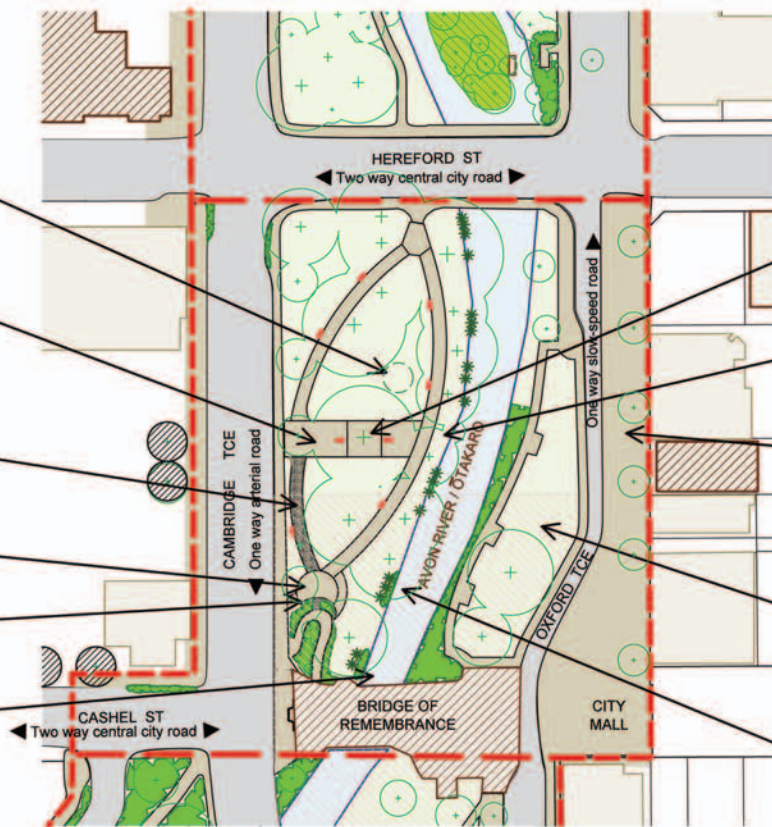
New memorial walk. A large paved walk with new seating and space for sculptures and memorials. Mulch or chip to be laid at base of trees in consultation with council arborist.

Existing path widened and improved with integrated lighting and seating. Header strips of brick, coloured paving to be installed.

New paved area at base of steps with a pattern signifying the Victoria Cross or similar.

New retaining wall acts also as a space for memorial plaques.

Explore opportunities for turning this outfall into a landscape feature



Large plane tree to be lit by subtle up lighting.

Widen and improve existing steps and railing.

Continue the use of the existing wide footpath for outdoor dining

Investigate replacement of the worn lawn with a paved area suitable for use as a stage for entertainers and special events, and designed to be used as an informal sitting and gathering place at other times

Margin planting of carex species at waters edge to reflect planting on opposite bank.

Prepare and implement a conservation plan for Remembrance Park and the Oxford Terrace berm, as part of the heritage setting for the Bridge of Remembrance. Include design guidelines for future memorials and plaques. This area has potential as a commemorative theme area and is a suitable setting for an artwork
