

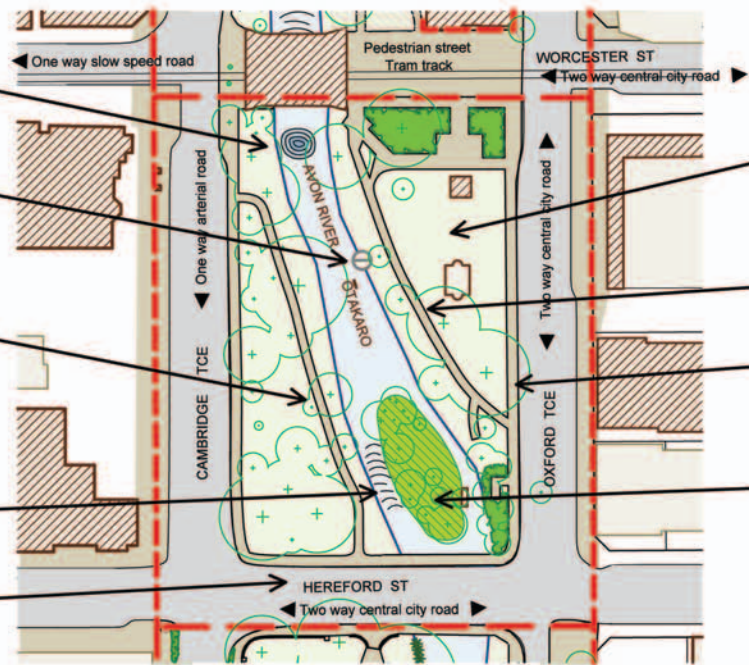
Explore opportunities for adding a viewing platform and improving the habitat of the adjacent pool

Explore opportunities for turning this outfall into a landscape feature

Replace two ginkgos. Select future commemorative trees from flowering cherries, magnolias, dogwoods, ginkgos. Retain and replace golden ash as highlight tree. Plant one or two totara in gaps as feature trees

Protect the important habitat within the channel west of Mill Island and remove dam from eastern channel to improve habitat potential.

Make the bridge roadway easier for pedestrians to cross and use



Prepare and implement a conservation and landscape plan to determine the heritage significance of the water feature and bedding displays and consider the potential to update them as the setting of the heritage Scott memorial statue. This park has potential as a commemorative theme area

Keep this existing pathway for pedestrians only

Encourage shared pedestrian and cyclist use of the roadside pathway

Prepare and implement a conservation and landscape plan to enhance the heritage Mill Island and its natural river setting in accord with the resource consent for the waterwheel. Consider motorising the wheel. Include planting of cabbage trees, tall podocarps such as kahikatea and rimu, and low growing shrubs.
