

Create a new riverside park by either narrowing the existing Cambridge Terrace roadway (1) closing off the road and adding a turning circle (2) or re-aligning the road to exit to Kilmore Street (3) add new paths, seats and Garden City planting. This park has potential as commemorative theme area and is a suitable setting for an artwork

Establish new pedestrian/cyclist crossing

Prepare and implement a conservation plan for the bridge and its setting

Explore opportunities to open up the visual and physical access from Colombo Street to the river berm and plant flowering cherries along the riverside

Prepare and implement a conservation plan for the heritage setting of the Plunket building. This could include termination of the existing lease over the carpark and turning the carpark into a riverside green space with seats and paving. It would make a good setting for an artwork. The conservation plan could also consider opening up the north side of the ground floor of the building to the river.

Redefine vehicle access with paved thresholds and improve pedestrian safety. Shift car parks to south side of Oxford Tce to reclaim river corridor as 'people place'.

Enhance street scene & river corridor with new specimen trees (*Liriodendron tulipifera columnaris*). Establish a tree lined 'promenade' with paving, seats and views. Open views & improve public access to Armagh & New Regent Streets. Relocate bus stop away from 'Gateway'

Turn the existing springfed outfall into a design feature. Extend riparian vegetation to provide a setting for the reconstructed waterway. Provide access for visitors to experience the water and the river

Carry out further analysis of siltation in this stretch of the river and how it might be better managed. Retain reclaimed area with *Juncus* spp to encourage variety in river width but remove any weeds from in-stream plantings.

Enhance Cambridge Tce with a paved threshold, a narrowed carriageway, realigned carparks and new specimen trees

Prepare and implement a conservation plan for the heritage setting of the band rotunda and the associated heritage street lights

South bank walk - develop pedestrian access and passive recreation with river margin path, informal seats and steps to river.

Explore opportunities to open up a pedestrian link to New Regent Street
