

## 9. CHRISTCHURCH, ROLLESTON AND ENVIRONS TRANSPORT STUDY CONTACT GROUP

The purpose of this report is to request the Board to nominate its representative(s) to an elected member contact group for the Christchurch, Rolleston and Environs Transport Study.

A briefing for this study was conducted on 5<sup>th</sup> March 2002 for elected members from the Community Boards affected by this study and the Sustainable Transport & Utilities Committee. At that meeting it was suggested that an elected members contact group be established for this study. The purpose of this group was to provide a forum for discussion with elected members on progress and matters related to this study without unnecessarily delaying the study by having to wait for scheduled board and committee meetings. An undertaking was made to still report on the study approximately bi-monthly, irrespective of the general progress and activity of the contact group.

At the 5<sup>th</sup> March briefing it was suggested that the contact group be composed of the Land Transport Sub-Committee plus one nominee from the Spreydon-Heathcote and Fendalton-Waimairi Community Boards and two nominees from the Riccarton-Wigram Community Board. The Board is requested to make the appropriate appointments at this meeting.

The beginning of the first consultation period for this study will be in the week of 15<sup>th</sup> April 2002. A stakeholder meeting will be held at Hornby High School on the evening of 17<sup>th</sup> April.

**Recommendation:** That the Board appoint nominee(s) for the Christchurch, Rolleston and Environs Transport Study elected member contact group.

**Chairman's Recommendation:** That the Board appoint Messrs Mike Mora and Bob Shearing, with Ken Cummings as a deputy onto the elected member contact group.
