The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval for the installation of a P5 Loading Zone (Goods Vehicles Only) on Colombo Street near the intersection of Sandyford Street.

A request has been received from Mr Gary Quaile the owner of 4 Winds Gallery at 460 Colombo Street to relocate the existing P5 Loading Zone to outside his new premises across the road at 461 Colombo Street. The proposal is shown on the plan below.

The building at 461 Colombo Street where the 4 Winds Gallery has relocated to, being an older building, has no provision for loading or unloading on site. Mr Quaile has requested this change so he can continue to trade in the Sydenham retail area.

This proposal will mean that two existing P30 parking spaces outside 461 Colombo Street will be changed to the new loading zone and the existing loading zone outside 460 Colombo Street will be changed to P30 parking.

Mr Quaile has confirmed that the Sydenham Business Association endorses the proposal.
