PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to obtain Board approval for acceptance of a tender which is above the \$500,000 authority delegated to Council Officers.

RELEVANT CURRENT POLICY

This project forms part of the City Street Unit's Capital Expenditure Programme for the 2001/02 and the 2002/03 financial years shown on page 71 of the Financial Plan and Programme.

DESCRIPTION

The contract is for the construction of kerbs, channels, asphaltic concrete paths, grassed berms, landscaping, paved platforms, drainage works, road shoulder restoration and carriageway reconstruction in Studholme Street from Barrington Street to Somerfield Street (refer attached map TP137201).

Tender prices have been received as follows:

K B Contracting & Quarries Limited	\$522,244.00
Local Construction Limited	\$525,134.00
The Isaac Construction Co Limited	\$536,322.75
Calcon Asphalt Limited	\$565,815.06

All prices exclude GST.

These prices include a contingency sum of \$44,000 and the work is for a twenty one (21) week period.

The estimate for the work was \$521,000.00.

RESULTS OF CONSULTATION

The standard roadworks information leaflet has been circulated inviting comments relating to the project and all enquiries and comments from residents and others have been satisfactorily resolved. Changes have had to be made to the design shown on the publicity leaflet which has been revised to reflect these changes.

Recommendation: That the lowest price conforming tender of KB Contracting & Quarries Limited, for the sum of \$522,244.00, be accepted for road works and related landscaping in Studholme Street.
