

10. WORDSWORTH STREET – P5 LOADING ZONE

The purpose of this report is to seek approval for the installation of a P5 Loading Zone on Wordsworth Street between Hawdon and Buchan Streets.

A request has been received from Mr Selwyn Everett the owner of Everett Automotive, 54 Buchan Street, for a P5 Loading Zone to be created outside his premises on Wordsworth Street. The proposal is shown on the plan below.

At present the kerbside parking outside Mr Everett's business is unrestricted so all-day parking occurs. The business dismantles vehicles and sells vehicle parts and accessories through a retail shop fronting onto Wordsworth Street at the corner of Buchan Street. With the limited parking available vehicles are stopping and parking on the existing no stopping lines to access the business. The no stopping lines are in place to provide a safe environment for vehicles using the Buchan/Wordsworth Streets intersection. The current situation compromises this safety.

This proposal will help solve the current situation. The loading zone will provide short-term parking for one or two vehicles for customers and deliveries to the business. It will also provide other businesses in the area with short-term parking for their deliveries.

Recommendation: That a P5 Loading Zone be created on the south side of Wordsworth Street commencing at a point 13 metres from its intersection with Buchan Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 10 metres.

Chairman's Recommendation: That the officer's recommendation be adopted.
