

5. APPROVAL OF VARIATIONS

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The purpose of this report is to recommend that Council give its decision on certain variations to the proposed City Plan.

In June 2002 the Council initiated some twenty variations to the proposed Plan in order to address a number of minor inconsistencies and errors that had been identified. Most of these variations attracted no submissions or, in the case of Variation 65, the only submission has been withdrawn. It is now appropriate that Council gives its decision on these matters pursuant to Clause 10(1) of the First Schedule to the Resource Management Act 1991. A table setting out the variations recommended for approval and their subject matter is attached to this report.
