The purpose of this report is to advise the Board of an application from residents of Petra Place for a refuse and recycling collection service and to seek the approval of the Board accordingly

In May 1997 the Council agreed to the extension of the refuse collection services down private rights of way (lanes) in accordance with certain criteria. This service was operational from August 1997 and is available on request assuming the criteria are met. The Board has a discretionary right to make a recommendation to approve or decline and application.

An application for this service has been received from the residents of Petra Place which is a residential complex for elderly persons, owned by Housing New Zealand. The application also carries the approval of Housing New Zealand.

Some of the residents will still need to bring their rubbish bags and recycling bins to the head of the turning bay as there is in sufficient room for the truck to manoeuvre in their area.

In all other aspects the application meets the requirements and the contractor has agreed to commence the service once approval has been granted.

Recommendation: That the application by the residents' of Petra Place for a refuse/recycling

collection service be approved.
