

## 7. WAIRAKEI ROAD - PROPOSED PARKING RESTRICTIONS

The purpose of this report is to request that the Board approve the installation of a five-minute parking restriction outside No. 520 Wairakei Road (a collector road).

A letter has been received from the owners of the premises at 522 Wairakei Road (where a takeaway business is operated by their tenant) requesting that a five-minute parking restriction be installed outside this property. There are no parking restrictions in this section of Wairakei Road. At present there is a significant demand for on street parking in Wairakei Road outside the takeaway shop from shop customers, and staff from local businesses. The existing long term parking demand leaves little or nothing for the shop customers. It is therefore in the interests of the local community that a P.5 parking restriction at 522 Wairakei Road be installed.

The Parking Unit and neighbouring businesses have been consulted and are in favour of the proposed restriction.

**Recommendation:** That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of five minutes on the north side of Wairakei Road commencing at a point 5 metres from the western boundary of No. 522 Wairakei Road and extending in a easterly direction for a distance of 13.5 metres.

**Chairman's Recommendation:** That the foregoing recommendation be adopted.
