## 20. COMMUNITY ADVOCATE'S UPDATE

# 20.1 Discretionary Fund Update

The attached schedule shows the Board's allocations to date since 1 July 2001. The balance remaining prior to this meeting is \$20,960.

## 20.2 Community Events and Special Days Fund

The Community, Policy and Finance Committee made a grant of \$1,000 to the Linwood Community Arts Centre Multicultural Event. A total of \$9,620 remains available for allocation.

#### 20.3 Community Response Fund

A request of \$100 for the incorporation fee received from the Ferrymead/Brookhaven Residents' Association was granted by the Chairperson and Deputy Chairperson to be allocated from the Community Response Fund. A total of \$4,900 remains available for allocation.

## 20.4 Board Objectives

The draft Board objectives and performance measures 2002-04 developed at the Board's planning day have been circulated to members. It is recommended that these be confirmed.

#### 20.5 Community Consultation

The Advocacy Team have been involved in the following major community consultation projects: Bus layover, Latimer Square enhancement, Tuam Street/Lichfield Street swap, Linwood Park and the Garden City Revival. Members may like to discuss these further.

## 20.6 Environment Canterbury Ticketing and Fare Review

Environment Canterbury is reviewing Christchurch's zone 1 bus tickets and fares system. A copy of the brochure has been circulated to members. Feedback is sought by Environment Canterbury by Friday, 8 March 2002.
