

10. TUAM STREET – PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to approve the installation of a no parking restriction in Tuam Street across the entrance to Nursery Road.

Last year the section of Nursery Road from Tuam Street to Cashel Street was upgraded with new kerb and channel, footpaths, landscaping and at Tuam Street a threshold was installed. This narrowed the road entrance and put the kerb in Tuam Street straight across with a vehicle cutdown for the traffic entrance.

The new work has created a problem with vehicles parking close to the vehicle cutdown. These vehicles block visibility for traffic exiting Nursery Road.

To increase visibility and make the intersection safer it is proposed to install a no parking restriction along part of the park frontage, across the vehicle cutdown and extending to the east to a point in line with the property boundaries.

Recommendation: That the parking of vehicles be prohibited on the north side of Tuam Street commencing at a point opposite the west kerb line of the south section of Nursery Road and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 26 metres.

Chairman's Recommendation: That the officer's recommendation be adopted.
