

**4. MERIVALE LANE/WINCHESTER STREET
- INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS**

The purpose of this report is to request that the Board approve the removal of two compulsory stop restrictions and the installation of four Give Way restrictions on the intersection of Merivale Lane and Winchester Street.

When the Board approved the work as shown on the **attached** plan for tender at its meeting on the 4 June 2002, the plan showed Give Way controls against Merivale Lane and Winchester Street on all approaches to the proposed roundabout at this intersection. The intersection is at present controlled by Compulsory Stop controls against Merivale Lane. Compulsory Stops are not appropriate controls for the approaches to a roundabout.

To fulfil the legal requirements the existing compulsory stop restrictions need to be formally removed and the Give Way controls installed.

- Recommendations:**
1. That the existing Stop Signs against Merivale Lane at its intersection with Winchester Street are removed.
 2. That Give Way signs be placed against Merivale Lane at both branches of its intersection with Winchester Street.
 3. That Give Way signs be placed against Winchester Street at both branches of its intersection with Merivale Lane.
