

## 6. SUBMISSIONS IN SUPPORT OF TRANSWASTE CANTERBURY LIMITED'S RESOURCE CONSENT APPLICATIONS

The purpose of this report is to seek the agreement of the Subcommittee to the lodging of submissions in support of the applications for resource consents for the Kate Valley regional landfill by Transwaste Canterbury Ltd.

It is suggested that the Subcommittee, on behalf of the shareholder Councils, lodge supporting submissions to the Transwaste Canterbury Ltd consent applications and that an appropriate consultant be engaged to assist the Subcommittee in this.

It should be noted that the Christchurch City Council has provided the sum of \$50,000 in its 2002/03 budget for professional fees in support of the Canterbury Waste Subcommittee and it is suggested that other shareholder councils also provide a proportionate amount. Part of this funding could be used for the Subcommittee's supporting submission.

Based on the cost sharing arrangements detailed in the constituting agreement, provision would be as follows:
