

18. MAIN NORTH ROAD : PROPOSED BUS STOP RELOCATION

The purpose of this report is to obtain the Board's approval for the relocation of the existing bus stop at 292 to 294 Main North Road at the north end of the Daniels Road shops (see attached plan).

A pedestrian crossing facility was constructed last year at 292 Main North Road that involved the construction of a kerb extension at the existing bus stop. Since the construction of the kerb extension the bus now blocks the kerbside through traffic lane when it stops at this stop. It is proposed to shift the stop to outside 294 Main North Road where the bus can park out of the through traffic lane. The owner of 294 Main North Road has been contacted for his approval to have the bus stop shifted to outside this property, and is in agreement with the proposal.

It is therefore proposed that the existing bus stop outside 292 Main North Road be shifted 20 metres to the north to outside 294 Main North Road.

- Recommendation:**
1. That a bus stop be removed from the east side of the Main North Road from its position commencing at a point 80 metres north of its intersection with Daniels Road and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 20 metres.
 2. That a bus stop be installed on the east side of the Main North Road commencing at a point 104 metres north of its intersection with Daniels Road and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 12 metres.

- Chairperson's Recommendation:**
1. That the officer's recommendations be adopted.
 2. That the City Streets Unit carry out an education campaign on the use of pedestrian crossing signals.
