

13. BAKER STREET, DENNITT STREET AND GRESHAM TERRACE: GIVE WAY SIGNS

The purpose of this report is to seek the Board's approval for the installation of Give Way signs in Baker Street at Bowhill Road, and Dennitt Street and Gresham Terrace at Keyes Road, as part of the kerb and channel renewal work proposed for this area.

Baker Street, Dennitt Street and Gresham Terrace all intersect with a collector road, and the provision of a Give Way control will provide priority to traffic on the collector roads, Bowhill and Keyes Roads (see attachment).

In the 2002/03 Capital Works programme, it is proposed to renew the kerbs and channels, paths and to carry out road reconstruction in Baker Street and Dennitt Street. Road narrowing is proposed at the intersections of Dennitt Street and Gresham Terrace, and again at approximately the mid-point between New Brighton Road and Gresham Street to deter speeding vehicles. The speed of vehicles in these streets is a concern for residents and is recognized in the North New Brighton Neighbourhood Improvement Plan. A pamphlet explaining the proposed work was distributed to residents in March 2002 for comments.

It is now appropriate to consider the installation of Give Way signs at these locations as part of this work, which is expected to be completed by June 2003.

This report meets the Community Board's Objective 6 for 2001/02.

- Recommendation:** That the Board approve the installation of the following Give Way controls:
1. That a Give Way sign be placed against Baker Street at Bowhill Road.
 2. That a Give Way sign be placed against Dennitt Street at Keyes Road.
 3. That a Give Way sign be placed against Gresham Terrace at Keyes Road.

Chairperson's Recommendation: That the abovementioned recommendation be adopted.
