The purpose of this report is to obtain Board approval for the acceptance of a tender which is above the \$500,000 authority delegated to Council Officers.

RELEVANT CURRENT POLICY

This project forms part of the Council's Capital Expenditure Programme for the 2002/2003 year and is shown as a Capital Output in the Financial Plan and Programme.

RESULTS OF CONSULTATION

The standard roadworks information leaflet has been circulated (**attached**) inviting comments relating to the project. Extensive consultation was carried out resulting in the installation of traffic signals at Straven/Matai intersection and all enquiries and comments from residents and others have been satisfactorily resolved.

DESCRIPTION

The contract is for the reconstruction of Straven Road between Weka Street and Kilmarnock Street.

Tender prices have been received as follows:

City Care Limited \$637,214.90 KB Contracting and Quarries Limited \$679,637.60 Local Construction Limited \$708,344.00

This project is within the Capital Works Budget.

All prices exclude GST.

These prices include a contingency sum of \$50,000.00 and the work is for a 21 week period.

The estimate for the work was \$590,142.20.

Frie Van der Krabben of City Care has given an assurance that the work can be completed within the specified time.
