## 11. NOTICE OF MOTION

## 11.1 LONG TERM COUNCIL COMMUNITY PLAN (LTCCP) REVOCATION OF PREVIOUS RESOLUTION

## BACKGROUND

At the 1 October Board meeting consideration was given to a report which included a request from the Council for the Board to initiate input into the preparation of a "Long Term Council Community Plan". This was expected to become a local authority requirement with the future enactment of a new Local Government Act.

Following the discussion on the particular clause the Board resolved: "that any further work by the Board on its input into the Long Term Council Community Plan lie on the table until the Local Government Bill is enacted."

## COMMENT

While the final form of the new Act still remains unclear it is not considered likely that there will be major amendment to the general thrust and requirements proposed by the Bill, and it would seem appropriate for the planning for consultation, and input to the Council, to now be initiated. The timeframe provided by the Council for completion of the task also suggests that the Board should commence its consideration prior to the Christmas holiday break.

For these reasons the undersigned members, in reconsideration of the 1 October outcome, now propose as follows:

- 1. That the 1 October 2002 Board resolution "that any further work by the Board on its input into the Long Term Council Community Plan lie on the table until the Local Government Bill is enacted" be revoked.
- 2. That the Finance and Planning Committee undertake the necessary work in deciding how best to collaborate with the community, and to formulate draft views on community outcomes and priorities, for consideration by the Board for later referral to the Council.
