

5. PAPANUI RSA

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The purpose of this report is to advise of a request from the Papanui RSA for a Council “Approved” concrete litter bin to be installed in the Association’s car park.

A letter has been received from the Papanui RSA asking the Board if it is possible to have litter bin similar to those on Papanui Road installed by the navy gun in their car park. They say that since the seats have been installed they have been used regularly by their own people and members of the public. The users would like somewhere to deposit their food containers etc.

City Streets Unit advise that they will not install and maintain litter bins on private property. They advise that the bins are able to be purchased and the costs, including installation, ranges from \$800 to \$1,000. At present there are no bins available, but are currently on order.

With regard to ongoing maintenance, including litter removal, this would be a matter of negotiation between the RSA and rubbish removal contractors including the Council’s contractors ie City Care and Metallic Sweepings.
