

12. WASTE 2002 CONFERENCE – COFFS HARBOUR, AUSTRALIA

The purpose of this report is to seek Council approval to the attendance of the Chairman, Councillor Denis O'Rourke and Councillor Sally Buck at the 'Waste 2002' Conference to be held at Coffs Harbour, Australia from 14 to 17 October 2002.

BACKGROUND

'Waste 2002' is an annual conference targeted at elected representatives and local authority staff which provides a forum for information exchange on emerging areas of waste management. The conference will consist of a two day technical tour of key waste management facilities in New South Wales including:

- The Swerf Plant at Wollongong,
- Bedmister Bio Conversion System at Port Stevens,
- Rethmann Facility at Port McQuarrie,
- Waste Services New South Wales, Eastern Creek Facility.

then a two day conference which will cover:

- Alternative technologies,
- Developments in organics processing,
- Strategy to tackle contamination,
- Different collection systems,
- Waste avoidance strategies,
- Resource derived fuels,
- Role of Resource New South Wales, Australia's newest state agency for resource management.

Key speakers include Australian local government elected representatives and staff and waste industry representatives from Australia and overseas. A conference outline is attached as appendix A.

COST

Estimated costs, excluding meeting allowances, are:
