6. IDRIS ROAD - PROPOSED KERB AND CHANNEL RENEWAL

The purpose of this report is to advise the Board that a publicity pamphlet for the renewal of the kerb and dish channels in Idris Road from Wairakei Road to Blighs Road is to be distributed for consultation.

Idris Road (a minor arterial road with an average traffic flow of 9,100 vehicles/day) is on the capital works programme to have its kerb and dish channel renewed in the 2003/2004 financial year. The local residents have been surveyed to get the issues they would like addressed with this work. Following consideration of the residents' feedback (see **attached** letter for a summary of their feedback) different options have been considered and the **attached** concept plan drawn up.

The sum of \$409,320 is budgeted for this project, which includes the undergrounding of the overhead services in the street. Work is programmed to start in November 2003.

To obtain feedback on the concept plan, the publicity pamphlet is to be distributed to residents' and property owners' in Idris Road.
