8. CASHEL STREET: P30 PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to seek the Board's approval to alter the parking restriction on the south side of Cashel Street east of Barbadoes Street (see attached plan).

Mr Grant Furlonger, Director of Bright Sparks Promotional Marketing at 292 Cashel Street, has requested that the existing 30 minute time limited parking to the west of this property be extended in an easterly direction across the front of the building. Currently this area has no time limit restriction on parking.

The extension of the 30 minute parking in front of 292 Cashel Street would allow for some short term parking in front of the building and would also benefit adjoining businesses. The other occupiers of 292 Cashel Street and the Parking Operations Manager support the proposed parking restriction change.

Recommendation:

That the Board approve the installation of the following parking restriction:

- That the existing parking of vehicles restricted to a maximum period of 30 minutes on the southern side of Cashel Street commencing at a point 48 metres from its intersection with Barbadoes Street and extending in a easterly direction for a distance of 26 metres, be revoked.
- 2. That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 30 minutes on the southern side of Cashel Street commencing at a point 48 metres from its intersection with Barbadoes Street and extending in a easterly direction for a distance of 45 metres.
