

7. LINWOOD AVENUE: P10 PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to seek the Board's approval to install a P10 (at any time) parking restriction on Linwood Avenue outside the Koki Dairy.

A request has been received from the owner of the Koki Dairy at 397 Linwood Avenue for a P10 (at any time) Parking Restriction outside his dairy. Currently vehicles of neighbouring properties are parking long term outside the dairy. The owner has requested that a P10 (at any time) parking restriction be placed outside his shop to stop all day parking but provide short-term parking for passing customers. The existing site details and proposal is shown on the plan below.



Linwood Avenue – Proposed P10 (at any time)

The proposal will solve the concerns mentioned above by providing an area for vehicles to park short term to access the dairy. It is known that the viability of the suburban dairy is dependent upon passing motorists having the ability to park kerbside outside the dairy when they wish otherwise they will drive past. The proposed P10 (at any time) parking restriction is located solely outside the dairy.

The Bromley Residents' Group endorses this proposal.

Staff

Recommendation: That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 30 minutes along the north east side of Linwood Avenue commencing at a point 4.5 metres south east of the common boundary of 395/397 Linwood Avenue and extending in a south easterly direction for a distance of 13 metres.

The Parking Manager agrees with this recommendation.
