

22. NOTICES OF MOTION

1. Meeting Remuneration

To consider the following motion, notice of which has been given by David Cox pursuant to Standing Order 2.16.1:

That in the spirit of reducing elected member costs to the City's ratepayers the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board cease paying elected members of the Board from 1 July 2003 for attendance at:

- (i) The Community Policy and Finance Committee*
- (ii) The Environment and Traffic Committee*
- (iii) Treaty of Waitangi Seminars*
- (iv) Any outside organisation to which a Board member is appointed on which other persons serve as unpaid volunteers.*

2. Project Fund – Civic Education and Awareness Project

To consider the following motion, notice of which has been given by David Cox pursuant to Standing Order 2.16.1:

Recognising the need to constrain the use of ratepayers' funds whenever possible and recognising that it is central government's responsibility to encourage people to vote.

It is moved:

- (i) That the \$5,000 allocated to the civic education and awareness project be returned to the 2003/04 Project Fund.*
- (ii) That the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board lobby central government to increase the funding allocated to the promotion of "eligibility to vote".*
