# **RESTELL STREET/HAREWOOD ROAD INTERSECTION SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS**

- 1. That the extension of the existing central median island, the banning of right turns and other improvements at the Restell Street/Harewood Road intersection, as illustrated on the attached plan, be supported by the Board.
- 2. That the plan be approved for consultation.
- 3. That the existing tall vegetation in the kerb build-outs in the proximity of the railway line be replaced with low maintenance ground cover planting.

#### **OWEN MITCHELL PARK – PLAYGROUND REDEVELOPMENT**

- 1. That the Board approve the plan for public consultation.
- 2. That Parks & Waterways staff consider engaging Inspectors John Doyle and Graham Cairns or the 'Crime Prevention through Environmental Design' trained safety auditors in the Parks & Waterways Unit to carry out an audit of the proposed plan.
- 3. That in the future Parks & Waterways adopt a process that ensures a Safer Parks audit is carried out on all plans before they are presented to the Shirley/Papanui Community Board.
