The purpose of this report is to obtain the approval by the Board of a new road name. Road and Right of Way name approvals are delegated to Community Boards. It is important that approved names will not duplicate or be similar to existing names. All names submitted have been checked by Council and NZ Post for duplication.

SANCTUARY GARDENS - SUBURBAN ESTATES LIMITED (SHIRLEY WARD)

This is the last stage of the Clearbrook Palms subdivision. This stage extends Sanctuary Gardens and Clearbrook Street and creates a new "hammerhead" shaped cul de sac. The eastern head will only be partly constructed at this point. One new road name is required for the cul de sac. The previous stages included names with a Florida and Caribbean influence such as Montego, Palm, Laguna and Cayman. The applicant company wish to continue the theme with the last name and have proposed the name **Havana Gardens** for the cul de sac.
