

14. ANTIGUA STREET – P30 PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval for a P30 Parking Restriction in Antigua Street adjacent to the dairy at the intersection of Fairfield Avenue.

A request has been received from the owner of the Fairfield Dairy, on the corner of Antigua Street and Fairfield Avenue, to install time restricted parking outside his premises on Antigua Street (see plan below). All-day parking of vehicles in the vicinity is causing problems for passing vehicles being able to park short term to access these shops. It is noted from the dairy owner’s request that the viability of suburban shops is dependant on short-term kerb-side parking.



Antigua Street – Proposed P30 Parking Restriction

It is believed that vehicles parked long-term outside the dairy belong to workers from the nearby commercial area on the eastern side of Antigua Street. This proposal will solve the access problems to the dairy for passing motorists and delivery vehicles. The proposed parking restriction is located solely outside the property of the dairy.

Staff

Recommendation: That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 30 minutes on the western side of Antigua Street commencing at a point 9 metres from its intersection with Fairfield Avenue and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 14.5 metres.
