

10. THORRINGTON ROAD AND WHERSTEAD ROAD: PROPOSED KERB AND CHANNEL RENEWAL

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The purpose of this report is to request the Board's approval for construction of the replacement of the dish channels in Thorrington Road and Wherstead Road with flat channel.

Both of these roads are local roads on the Capital Works Programme, scheduled to have kerb and dish channel renewed in the 2003/2004 financial year. The local residents, Thorrington School, and businesses have been contacted by publicity pamphlet and public meeting to obtain feedback on the attached concept plan TP149902.

Following consideration of the residents' feedback (see attached letter for a summary of their feedback), the left turn out from Thorrington Road onto Cashmere Road has been altered and approval will be sought from the Strategy and Resources Committee to bring Woodbridge Road kerb and channel renewal forward in the Capital Works Programme to enable the work to be done concurrently with Thorrington and Wherstead Roads. This proposal will be covered in a separate report.

An amount of \$785,336 is budgeted for this project, which does not include the undergrounding of the overhead services in the street. Work is programmed to start in September/October 2003.
