## 13. PROPOSED NEW ROAD NAME: DEAVOLL PLACE

The purpose of this report is to obtain the Board's approval of one new road name. Road name approvals are delegated to Community Boards.

It is important that approved road names do not duplicate, or be similar to, existing road names. The name submitted below has been checked by the Council and NZ Post for duplication.

## 41 Truscotts Road: Heathcote Recreational Holdings Limited

Ferrymead Ward

The first stage of this subdivision extended Cooks Lane. A second stage will create eight new residential allotments served by a new cul de sac (see attached plan). The developers/applicants have proposed using names long associated with the land.

The name **Deavoll Place** is proposed. The Deavoll family has lived in the valley since 1880 and the family's fourth generation is still resident in the valley. Daniel Deavoll farmed the land in the 1880's, together with relatives of the Munnings and Cooks families, milking cows and delivering milk to the neighbourhood. Clifford and Stan Deavoll (Daniel's sons) were also involved with the land, with Clifford Deavoll helping to farm the land and working as a water carrier, drawing water from a well on one of the paddocks. His brother Stan bought some of the valley land and farmed it with a relative of the Cooks. Clifford's son Gerald also farmed the land in conjunction with Phil Garrett who continued dairying until 1986.
