

5. BERWICK STREET – PROPOSED P10 PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval to install a P10 Parking Restriction on Berwick Street outside the Berwick Street Church.

A request has been received from the YWCA Neighbourhood Kitchen for a P10 Parking Restriction outside the Berwick Street Church at No. 10 Berwick Street. The kitchen provides meals for a 'Meals on Wheels' service from Monday to Friday throughout the day. The kitchen is attached to the church at the rear of the site. Volunteers use their own cars to deliver the meals to the elderly and people in need. The church site is such that no off-street parking or drive on access is available for the collection of the meals. This is done kerb side outside the premises on Berwick Street.

This request has come about due to all day parking of vehicles at this location by workers from the nearby businesses at the Berwick/Cranford Streets intersection. These workers tend to park away from their own premises but are possibly unaware that they are parking outside another.



PROPOSED P10 PARKING RESTRICTION

By installing a short length of P10 Parking Restriction the access to the kitchen for meal collection will be much improved. It is proposed to install the restriction for three vehicles and this will be solely located outside the church for standard hours, ie 8:00am to 6:00pm, but limited to Monday to Friday so as not to affect church services at the weekend.

Recommendation: That a P10 Parking Restriction be created on the south side of Berwick Street commencing at a point 51.5 metres from its intersection with Cranford Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 17 metres.
