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The reports of the Seminar meetings held on 18 June 2003 and 16 July 2003 are attached.

At the Seminar meeting of 18 June 2003:

- (a) The children of Papanui Street School presented the Board with a report on their field trip in the 'Living Streets' pilot study area and their recommendations for the improvement of their community.
- (b) Inspector Graeme Cairns of the Papanui Police provided the Board with an update on police activities and business in the Shirley/Papanui community.
- (c) Ollie Clifton, the Community Recreation Adviser, reported on his experiences and the knowledge he gained from a Community Recreation exchange to Calgary, Canada.
- (d) Barry Straight, Area Contract Manager (Eastern), Parks and Waterways Greenspace and Utilities Maintenance, introduced himself to the Board.

SPEED LIMITS

That the proposed speed limit changes be adopted.

ST MATTHEWS ANGLICAN CHURCH

That the Community Development Adviser report to the Board on the feasibility of providing a grant to St Matthews Parish to assist with community activities.

MANAGEMENT GUIDELINES FOR COMMUNITY FACILITIES

That the Board support all the recommendations in the Background Report on Reviewed Management Guidelines for Community Facilities, especially recommendations 3 and 8.
