The purpose of this report is to seek the Board's approval to an application for funding from its 2003/04 Youth Development Fund.

Her experiences in volunteering have enabled her to develop her leadership and communication skills, as well as cementing her dedication for her chosen sport.

The applicant has affiliations with Synchronised Swimming New Zealand and the Pioneer Synchronised Swimming Club, the latter having provided a letter of support.
