The purpose of this report is to submit the following outcomes from the Working Party's 17 December meeting.

**PRESENT:** Yiyi Ku (Chairman), Sally Buck, Val Carter and Barbara Stewart.

**1. APOLOGIES**

An apology for absence was received and accepted from Mike Wall.

**2. PUBLIC ART PROJECT**

As agreed at the Working Party's previous meeting the main intention for the present meeting was to visit a number of sites around the city where public art work had been introduced in past years.

The Working Party visited sites around the city and returned to the Fendalton office to reconvene for further discussion.

The Community Recreation Adviser presented illustrations (via the overhead projector) of a number of other art works from within the city, and in various locations overseas.

The Working Party considered the best method for identifying preferred locations within the Fendalton/Waimairi community, and **agreed** that it would be useful for Fendalton members, and Waimairi members, to meet informally separately to identify the preferred location for each Ward.

The Working Party, following this step, would then reconvene to discuss the next steps in the process for achieving art work(s) in this community.

The Working Party noted again the opportunity for incorporating art work(s) in conjunction with upcoming capital works, and the Community Recreation Adviser agreed to provide a list of these works for the 2003/04 year.

The meeting concluded at 10.55 am.
