

7. WILFRID STREET - PROPOSED KERB AND CHANNEL RENEWAL

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The purpose of this report is to request that the Board approve for distribution the **attached** publicity plan for the renewal of the dish channels on both sides for the full length of Wilfrid Street.

BACKGROUND

Wilfrid Street (a local road carrying an average of 280 vehicles per day) was originally on the Capital Works Programme to have its kerb and dish channel renewed in the 2002/2003 financial year. The local residents have been surveyed and a meeting held to get the issues they would like addressed with this work. Following consideration of the resident's feedback (see **attached** letter for a summary of their feedback) different options have been considered and the proposal shown on the plan has been drawn up.

The amount of \$247,855 is budgeted for this project. Physical works have been reprogrammed to early part of 2003/04 due to industry work overload.

The overhead services shall not be undergrounded, as there is no money budgeted for the work.

To obtain the residents and property owners feedback on the concept plan it is recommended that the publicity plan be distributed.
