The purpose of this report is to obtain the approval by the Board for one new Road name. Road name approvals are delegated to Community Boards. GRIMSEYS ROAD - ST BEDES ESTATE - PAPANUI WARD

This is a residential subdivision for some of the vacant land owned by St Bedes College Trust Board. The subdivision will create forty-five residential sections and a new reserve, to be served by a large 'hammerhead' shaped cul de sac running west off Grimseys road near Te Maru Place (see attached plan). The applicants have proposed the name 'Providence Place' for the cul de sac. Providence, according to the Collins Dictionary, is "the kindly care of God or nature; foresight or economy". There is a City of Providence in Rhode Island, named by its early settlers for "God's guidance and care".
