The purpose of this report is to advise Community Boards of the attendance record of the Neighbourhood Week walks held in 2002.

The Neighbourhood Week Committee has requested that all Community Boards be informed of the attendance records for 2002 and for each Board to decide if they will continue to have Neighbourhood Week walks within their area in 2003.

Attendances for the six walks held were 210 people. Two of these walks were already the Active Programme walks that have a history of good attendances whereas two walks had to be cancelled due to poor weather.

Feedback from the Leisure Unit was that over the past two years, the number of attendees has been very low despite the best efforts to promote the event.
