

## 10. COLOMBO STREET "P10 AT ANY TIME"

The purpose of this report is to obtain the Board's approval for the installation of a P10 parking restriction that operates for 24 hours a day on the east side of Colombo Street, just south of the signals at Strickland Street.

Currently the Beckenham shops are covered by P30 parking restrictions which extend into Tennyson Street. In recent times there have been a number of restaurants opened in the area. Customers of these restaurants park in the P30 areas, thus preventing customers for the takeaways from finding a parking space. A number of shops on the east side have shifted or gone out of business. The remaining shops would like to see a short-term 24-hour parking restriction. There are two parking spaces situated between vehicle entrances which would facilitate easy access for short-term parking that would be ideal for a "P10 At Any Time" restriction.

### Staff

- Recommendation:**
1. That the P30 parking restriction on the east side of Colombo Street, commencing at a point 26 metres from the intersection of Tennyson Street and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 49.5 metres, be revoked.
  2. That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 30 minutes on the east side of Colombo Street, commencing at a point 26 metres from its intersection with Tennyson Street and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 24.5 metres.
  3. That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of '10 minutes at any time' on the east side of Colombo Street, commencing at a point 55.5 metres from its intersection with Tennyson Street and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 26 metres.
