

12. SPEED CHECK TRAILER – REQUEST FOR FUNDING

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The purpose of this report is to request funding from the Board to support the operation of a speed check trailer in the Spreydon/Heathcote area.

At the time of purchase of the speed check trailer (funded from the Board's 2000/01 Project Fund in 2000), all community boards agreed to pay one-sixth of the annual rental (being \$700 each).

The speed check trailer is in the process of being upgraded in order that it will record speeds in certain areas. Although actual statistics are unavailable for the past year, City Streets Unit staff advise that very positive feedback has been received from the community in terms of its effectiveness.

By supporting this request the Board would be meeting one of its measures to achieve the output of "a safe community" (eg, road users, especially pedestrians and cyclists, feel safe on our streets).
