11. APPLICATION BY VODAFONE TO LOCATE MOBILE PHONE EQUIPMENT ON COUNCIL PROPERTY

The purpose of this report is to seek the Committee's approval for Vodafone to install two roadside telecommunication sites within Christchurch.

These approvals are required to enable Vodafone to proceed with their application for resource consent.

CONTEXT OF REPORT

As part of the protocol/policy as presented to April's meeting, applications for cell sites must be approved by the Property and Major Projects Committee under its delegated authority. Applications have been received for two medium impact sites, these are modifications to applications presented at last month's Committee meeting.

APPLICATIONS RECEIVED

Two applications have been received from Vodafone seeking approval to develop roadside telecommunications facilities on Council street assets. These applications update two already presented to the Property and Major Projects Committee at last month's meeting. The first application (New Brighton Road) has been varied by Vodafone to better meet their needs in terms of coverage and the second (Marine Parade) represented in a varied location at the Committee's wish away from the children's playground. Officers are seeking approval from the Committee as part of the procedure for processing applications to locate mobile phone equipment on Council land.

These applications are consistent with the Council's protocol/policy for cellular transmitting sites and the following sites require approval in accordance with Step 12 of the protocol. Step 12 of the protocol is the final approval step for low/medium impact sites on street assets.

- 1. A roadside telecommunications facility on a street light pole situated on the intersection of Cresswell Avenue and New Brighton Road, Dallington as per Plan 1 (attached).
- 2. A roadside telecommunications facility on a street light pole situated on marine Parade, North New Brighton as per Plan 2 (attached).
