The purpose of this report is to inform the Board of feedback received from recipients of grants allocated by the Community Board.

### CHRISTCHURCH NORTH CITIZENS ADVICE BUREAU

Christchurch North Citizens Advice Bureau returned the acknowledgement form and a breakdown of costs in relation to an allocation of \$10,000 that they received from the Board's 2002/03 Project Funds. The Bureau also received \$10,000 from the Fendalton/Waimairi Community Board. The money was used for the Bureau's wages and operational costs.

### SHIRLEY COMMUNITY TRUST

The Shirley Community Trust thanked the Board for the 2003/03 Project Funds grant of \$20,000 towards the establishment and running of an OSCAR programme in Shirley. Salaries accounted for \$15,967.49 of the grant and the balance was spent on set-up and running costs. Shirley Primary School provides a permanent room for the programme and the numbers of those attending are climbing.

### KAPUATOHE RESERVE

Kapuatohe Historic Reserve Committee advise that the irrigation system, for which the Board allocated \$2,536.88 from its 2002/03 Discretionary Funds, has been installed.
