

10. FIFIELD TERRACE: PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

The purpose of this report is to advise that the Spreydon/Heathcote Community Board of a publicity pamphlet/concept plan for proposed works to improve traffic safety in Fifield Terrace between Ensors Road and Beckford Road as shown on the attached plan.

HISTORY

The Council has received complaints regarding the speed of vehicles using this section of Fifield Terrace. While this road forms part of the route for parents dropping their children off at St Marks, Opawa, and Rudolf Steiner Schools it is not an obvious shortcut for through-traffic. Fifield Terrace (a local road carrying 600 vehicles per day outside No. 247) is on the Neighbourhood Improvement Programme for the 2003/2004 financial year.

The objectives of the project are to: -

- Slow through-traffic and
- Improve intersection safety at Ford Road intersection.

The residents and property owners of Fifield Terrace have been surveyed to check the issues they would like addressed with this work. Following consideration of the residents' feedback (see attached letter for a summary of their feedback) different options have been considered and the attached concept plan drawn up.

The total of \$115,000 is budgeted for this project.

PROPOSAL

To obtain the residents' and property owners' feedback on the concept plan it is proposed it be distributed as a publicity pamphlet.
