

5. STRATFORD STREET - PROPOSED KERB AND CHANNEL RENEWAL

The purpose of this report is to request that the Board approve for consultation the publicity plan **attached** for the renewal of the dish channels for the full length of Stratford Street.

Stratford Street (a local road with an average traffic flow of 1100 vehicles/day) is on the capital works programme to have its kerb and dish channel renewed in the 2003/2004 financial year. The local residents have been surveyed to get the issues they would like addressed with this work. Following consideration of the feedback (see **attached** letter for a summary of their feedback) different options have been considered and the submitted plan drawn up.

The amount of \$391,685 is budgeted for this project.

There is no money budgeted for the undergrounding of the overhead services in the street, but the residents are hoping to put a 50/50 cost sharing proposal to the Council in the near future.

To obtain the residents and property owners feedback on the concept plan, it is proposed that a publicity pamphlet be distributed to residents and property owners in Stratford Street.
