

### 13. BORDESLEY STREET PROPOSED KERB AND CHANNEL RENEWAL

The purpose of this report is to request that the Board approve for consultation the publicity plan appended for the renewal of the dish channels for the section of Bordesley Street between Harrow Street and Olliviers Road.

Bordesley Street (a local road with an average traffic flow of 450 vehicles/day) is on the Capital Works Program to have its kerb and dish channel renewed in the 2003/2004 financial year. The local residents have been surveyed to get the issues they would like addressed with this work. Following consideration of the residents' feedback (see the attached letter for a summary of their feedback) different options have been considered and the attached plan drawn up. Two residents complained of the ugly overhead wiring. Unfortunately there is no monies budgeted for the undergrounding of the overhead wiring, therefore the Council will be unable to meet this request.

There have been no traffic accidents reported in the last five years to the Land Transport Safety Authority in this section of Bordesley Street.

The amount of \$231,000 is budgeted for this project.

To obtain the residents' and property owners' feedback on the attached concept plan, it is recommended that a publicity pamphlet be distributed to residents and property owners in this section of Bordesley Street showing the proposed layout.
