

15. PROPOSED NEW RIGHT OF WAY NAME – RED ROCK LANE

The purpose of this report is to obtain the Board’s approval to one new right of way name. Right of way name approvals are delegated to Community Boards.

It is important that approved names do not duplicate or be similar to existing names.

The Council and NZ Post have checked the name submitted for duplication.

59-93 Bay View Road R & C Meyers and ORS

Ferrymead Ward

An existing right of way serves thirteen properties at 25,45 and 59-93 Bay View Road. The right of way is formed and sealed. The owners of the properties have experienced difficulties with delivery drivers finding their properties, and relief post staff have difficulty locating letterboxes. The owners also believe that naming the right of way will provide their properties with their own identity. The name proposed by all the owners for the right of way is **Red Rock Lane**. The lane sits on the site of the old quarry from which the red rock, readily seen in Sumner and Redcliffs was extracted. At the entrance to the lane sits a very large red rock, which is used to locate the lane. The proposed name is considered appropriate and will not be confused with any existing names presently in use.
