

10. ROSE STREET BUS STOP RELOCATION

The purpose of this report is to seek the Board's approval for the relocation of one bus stop in Rose Street.

BACKGROUND

The owner of 5 Rose Street has requested that the bus stop on the northern side of Rose Street, currently positioned near the corner of Hoon Hay Road, be relocated further east along Rose Street outside Centennial Park. The reasons for this request are perceived safety concerns. The bus stop is served by the 20 Cracroft and Orbiter bus services.

DISCUSSION

It is proposed to relocate the bus stop, as requested, to outside Centennial Park. The proximity of Centennial Park allows for this request to be undertaken without any significant change in the level of service for bus passengers.

It will also allow for easier provision of future infrastructure at this stop as it would no longer be outside a residential property.

CONSULTATION

The Parks and Waterways Unit are agreeable to this relocation.

- Recommendation:**
1. That the bus stop on the northern side of Rose Street commencing at a point 29.5 metres from its intersection with Hoon Hay Road and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 12 metres be deleted.
 2. That a bus stop be installed on the northern side of Rose Street commencing at a point 82.5 metres from its intersection with Hoon Hay Road and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 17.5 metres.
